**It's in my mind to go somewhere sunny**  
*(I have it in mind to go to...)*

More examples:

*I can't do it now, but I'll keep it in mind.*

*I think it was always in his mind to get together with Sue.*

**2 be on my mind = troubling, worrying me**



**The baby's health is on my mind at the moment**

More examples:

*Sorry to be so distracted, but I've got a lot of things on my mind.*

*That leaking roof has been on Sam's mind for weeks.*

**3 to my mind = in my opinion**



**I'm sorry, but to my mind, you look silly in that hat.**

More examples:

*To my mind, we need to reconsider the way we educate our children.*

*This is not, to my mind, the best way to go.*
