### Worksheet (do this)

**Anybody** etc is positive, but it can also be used in questions and negatives.

- 1 **Anybody** (positive): "an unlimited number of people"  
Also **anything** (an unlimited number of things), **anywhere** (an unlimited number of places)



**"You can say anything, I don't mind!"**

*Anybody can use the internet  
She's happy to go anywhere.*

- 2 We often use **anybody** etc in questions:  
(The question can be a verb which questions: *wonder...*)



**"Is anybody there?"**

*Can you see anything?  
Are you going anywhere?*

- 3 **Not...anybody** is negative: "not one person" (= "nobody")  
The negative can be *not, never ...*, or a negative verb (*doubt...*)



**I doubt if he goes anywhere.**

*He didn't see anybody yesterday.  
He never does anything.*
